Proclamation

- WHEREAS: In Minnesota, a professional engineer is legally responsible for projects affecting the public welfare or the safeguarding of life, health, or property; and
- WHEREAS: The expertise of professional engineers is required when professional services involve the application of principles of mathematics and physical and applied engineering sciences, acquired through education, training, and experience; and
- WHEREAS: In Minnesota, no person other than one licensed under Minnesota law as a professional engineer may use the term "professional engineer"; and
- WHEREAS: Professional engineers have passed rigorous national examinations, and those licensed in Minnesota must also complete continuing education every two years to maintain their licenses; and
- WHEREAS: Professional engineers in Minnesota accept enforceable legal and ethical responsibilities to bring the necessary technical competence to their work and prioritize the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesotans who use the state's roads and bridges, buildings, water treatment plants, hospitals, and public infrastructure benefit every day from the commitment of professional engineers to public safety.

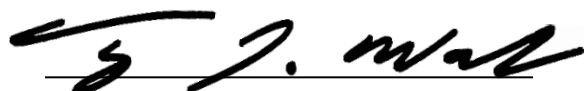
NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, August 6, 2025, as:
